Digital Antenna

- TV antennas allow you to pick up extra channels in your area.
- These 'live over-the-air' channels may include: ABC, CBS, FOX, NBC, PBS affiliates and independent stations.
- An indoor digital antenna hooks up to a single TV to pick up over-the-air programming.

- An online provider of entertainment (music, movies, etc.) that delivers the content via an Internet connection to the subscriber's computer, TV or mobile device.
- Netflix, Amazon Prime and Hulu are high-profile examples

Streaming Review

- The technology of transmitting audio and video files in a continuous flow over a wired or wireless internet connection.
- Streaming refers to any media content live or recorded delivered to computers and mobile devices via the internet and played back in real time.

- Netflix offers thousands of TV shows and movies of every genre and interest.
- Netflix offers full seasons of popular TV shows, exclusive blockbuster movies and award winning Netflix original programming

Hulu

- Hulu offers current episodes of network TV shows, full seasons of exclusive series, movies and its own award winning original programing.
- Hulu partners with major companies such as FOX, ABC, NBC, CBS, ESPN, AMC and BBC.

These partnerships enable Hulu to stream content right after it airs on cable
 TV.

Amazon Prime Video

- <u>Amazon Prime Video</u> is a streaming service that is automatically included with every Amazon Prime membership.
- Amazon has its own original programing, as well as options to rent other premium content
- You can also subscribe to other networks and pay an additional monthly cost

Disney Plus

- <u>Disney Plus</u> is an on-demand, ad-free streaming service where subscribers will be able to enjoy media content from Disney, Pixar, Marvel, Star Wars, National Geographic and 20th Century Fox.
- This subscription also includes original programming exclusive to Disney+.

Discovery Plus and Paramount Plus

- <u>Discovery Plus</u> is designed to provide easy access to all your favorite Discovery,
 TLC, Animal Planet, Food Network and HGTV series in one on-demand streaming app.
- The service also features a selection of brand-new exclusive programs you won't find anywhere else.
- <u>Paramount Plus</u> offers content from a variety of ViacomCBS brands

Digital Media Players

- A device that streams content from the Internet or a computer to a TV.
 - Examples include: a smart TV, stereo, home theater system or game console that plays audio or video material and/or displays photos.
- Connects to the user's internet network via Ethernet or Wi-Fi and to the TV (A/V receiver) using an HDMI cable.

Roku

- Best overall streaming device with the most options
- Cheap and cost effective
- Airplay features allow you to mirror compatible smart devices to your TV

Firestick

- Amazon's Digital Media Player
- Built in voice remote featuring Alexa

Apple TV

- Best for Apple Fans
- Syncs with other Apple devices
- Features Siri, games and other Apple Bundles

Google Chromecast

- Works well with other Google services such as Youtube TV and Google Photos
- Best for users already using Google smart products

Smart TV

- Smart TVs incorporate software that allows you to access and manage streaming
 platforms and other apps without the need to connect to an additional box (such
 as cable, Roku, Apple TV, Firestick, etc.)
- The TV must be connected to the internet via wifi or ethernet
